CCCS Announces Cathie Cline as Finalist in Pueblo Community College Presidential Search

Finalist to participate in public forum on March 15

March 14, 2024 (Denver) – Joe Garcia, chancellor of the Colorado Community College System (CCCS), announced Cathie Cline, Ed.D., as a finalist in the Pueblo Community College (PCC) presidential search today. She is the current president of East Arkansas Community College. Read her biography on the <u>PCC website</u>.



Cline joins Chato Hazelbaker and Kirk Young as one of three finalists in the running. The successful candidate will succeed outgoing president Dr. Patricia Erjavec, who will retire from the position in May after 14 years with the college.

Cline will visit PCC tomorrow, March 15, to participate in a variety of stakeholder meetings and a community open forum to share her experiences and interest in the position. The forum will take place virtually and in person on the Pueblo Campus from 3 to 3:45 in the Hoag Theater. <u>Use this link to join virtually via WebEx.</u>

Cline was selected following a national search conducted in collaboration with executive search firm, <u>Isaacson, Miller</u>. A nine-member search advisory committee, comprised of college and community representatives, identified the best candidates to move forward to the final round of selection.

Community feedback is instrumental to the selection process. CCCS encourages community members and stakeholders to <u>complete this survey</u> following Cline's open forum. Chancellor Garcia will review the results before making his final decision.
