

# Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program

## Admissions Process

The Bachelor in Diagnostic Medical Sonography program is a full-time commitment. People interested in the program must comply with the admission requirements and submit an application.

Application must be received by April 1st each year. Interview dates will be between the end of May and early June.

If selected and admitted into the program, notification will be sent by the end of June.

The Admission Sequence:

1. Determine Eligibility: Applicants must hold a two-year degree, preferably in allied health, or two-year equivalent credits from a four-year university. A minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.00 (C) for all completed course work is required.
2. Apply for Admission to Pueblo Community College. Have official transcripts sent to PCC for evaluation.

**NOTE:** Official transcripts are requested and sent directly from one institution to another

3. Complete all prerequisite courses. Transfer in grades on transcripts.
4. Submit completed application and all required documents on the checklist by April 1st.

**NOTE:** Incomplete applications will not be processed. Applications received after the submission date will not be considered.

5. Qualified applicants will be notified for an interview that will take place between the end of May and first two weeks of June.
6. Selected students will be notified by the end of June.

**NOTE:** Prior to beginning the Program, selected students will be required to: 1. Complete a Drug Screen. 2. Complete a Criminal Background Check. 3. Complete CPR Course. 4. Obtain Required Immunizations. 5. Purchase Malpractice Insurance.
