Heritage Trail Disc Golf Course rules:

- No supervisor on duty. Hours of permitted use are from dawn until dusk.
- No motorized vehicles/bicycles allowed on the course.
- No weapons, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products allowed on the course/campus.
- No dogs allowed on the course/campus. Service animals are permitted only as defined by PCC Operating Protocol & Procedure 902.
- No children under 15 years of age permitted without adult supervision.
- Users are responsible for removing their own trash. No littering.
- No tagging baskets; this is vandalism of state property.
- No modifying of the course.

This course is open to the public and is property of Pueblo Community College. PCC policies and procedures will be enforced at all times.
