36 credits (Nursing curriculum) x \$379.25 =	\$13,653.00
7 credits (General Education) x \$291.00 =	\$2,037.00
Total cost	\$15,690.00

General Education requirements taken online are \$403.50/credit
Non-Resident Nursing Curriculum requirements are \$734.85/credit
Non-Resident General Education requirements taken on campus are \$718.35/credit
