NUA 1001 (4 Credits x \$280.20) =	\$1,120.80

**Pass-through Fees may include:**

- **NUA 1070:** Malpractice Insurance & ID - \$27.36; Clinical Orientation DVD - \$30.00
- **Not included:** Scrubs, books, clinical shoes, nametags, gait belt, watch with a second hand, State Board license exam fees, and miscellaneous.
- **Other Fees:** CPR Certification \$50 - \$75; Immunizations \$75.00-\$150.00; Background/Drug screen \$47 - \$80 (depending on length of Colorado residency).
