Resident Tuition with the College Opportunity Fund (COF)	
NUA 1001 (4 Credits) =	\$850.95
NUA 1070 (1 Credit) =	\$225.60
<b>Total cost</b>	<b>\$1,076.55</b>
Resident Tuition without the College Opportunity Fund (COF)	
NUA 1001 (4 Credits x \$341.60) =	\$1,314.95
NUA 1070 (1 Credit x \$341.60) =	\$341.60
<b>Total cost</b>	<b>\$1,656.55</b>

**Pass-through Fees may include:**

- **NUA 1070:** Malpractice Insurance & ID - \$27.36; Clinical Orientation DVD - \$30.00
- **Not included:** Scrubs, books, clinical shoes, nametags, gait belt, watch with a second hand, State Board license exam fees, and miscellaneous.
- **Other Fees:** CPR Certification \$50 - \$75; Immunizations \$75.00-\$150.00; Background/ Drug screen \$47 - \$80 (depending on length of Colorado residency).
