Resident Tuition with College Opportunity Fund (COF)

Resident Tuition without the College Opportunity Fund (COF)	
43.5 credits (Nursing curriculum) x \$370.40 =	\$16,112.40
28 credits (General Education) x \$285.10 =	\$7,982.80
Total cost	\$24,095.20
