Angie Shehorn (Children First)

1. <u>HB23-1290</u>

Angie stated parents will be notified Wednesday about the first round of matching. She reported there were some snags, but it is being worked out. She stated the process will change going forward to address issues. Angie stated this is a clean-up bill to respect voter's intent of bill when passed in 2020. She reported there is over \$22 million over the original budget and voters will have to give permission for the department to keep the funds. Discussion ensued.

# D. TA Guide – Strength-Based Environmental Rating Scale

Angie Shehorn (Children First)

Angie reported the State is changing their direction regarding licensing. She stated they sent out a technical assistance guide to help prepare for a licensing visit. She included the strength-based environmental rating sheet which helps identify four to five strength-based items per program every time they go in. Angie said it is a way to show programs where they need more work to go through a quality improvement rating. She stated they will receive a higher payment from CCCAP (Colorado Child Care Assistance Program) if their rating is higher.

# E. Colorado Shines funding

Angie mentioned licensed programs can take part in the Colorado Opportunity Fund that can be used for coaching, materials and professional development starting July 1. She stated if any licensed program is interested, please contact the Children First team. She mentioned if the program is a Level I, they will have two years to receive support before submitting for a rating. Angie said if the program is a Level II, it is eighteen months before they submit for a rating.
