<b>Resident Tuition with College Opportunity Fund (COF)</b>	
30.5 credits (Nursing curriculum) x \$374.85 <sup>(est)</sup> =	\$11,432.93
18 credits (General Education) x \$164.20 <sup>(est)</sup> =	\$2,955.60

<b>Resident Tuition without College Opportunity Fund (COF)</b>

<b>Total cost =</b>	<b>\$20,014.53</b>
