



Building Skills for the Future

PCC Southwest's workforce training program will have in-class and experiential learning, during which students will complete remodels and new construction of blighted properties.

Through a partnership with the Colorado attorney general, this six-week program allows students to spend time in class and labs. Students will receive a \$15 an hour stipend for their Saturday work in the lab.

All materials will be provided. Students will have access to equipment normally found on a job site, including power tools, ladders, and safety equipment.

Introduction to Basic Construction Skills (NCCER Core) includes:

- Construction site safety orientation
- Intro to construction math
- Intro to hand tools
- Intro to power tools
- Intro to construction drawings
- Intro to basic rigging
- Basic communication skills
- Basic employment skills
- Intro to material handling
